

CANSail Level 2 Standard



A student completing their CANSail 2 standard has refined their CANSail 1 skills and will be comfortable commanding a dinghy in winds up to 12 knots in the absence of a support boat on the water. They will be able to comfortably sail to & from the dock, adjust the sails properly to the wind, keep the boat properly balanced and be capable of self rescuing a capsized dinghy including knowing how to prevent the dinghy from capsizing into the trutled position (thus preventing the mast from getting stuck in the mud). For each performance objective your instructor will evaluate you as "further development required" or as performing consistently.
