### **Teaching Rubbermaid Blue Box Items**

1. White board with markers and eraser
2. 10 knot lines – 5 each of thick and thinner lines
3. Ottawa River laminated 1550 Chart
4. Chart 1
5. Teaching Boat Binder (see below)
6. Safe boating Guide
7. Wind, weather and wave publication
8. Engine manual specific to the type of engine on the boat
9. COBBIE – a fender with a loop of yellow polypropylene line that will also likely have a face drawn on it. He can also live in the cockpit lockers once the season is underway.

### **Sails:**

1. Main – Stays attached to boom, disconnect the halyard
2. Head Sail Tanzer
  - a. 110%
  - b. 140%
  - c. 180%
3. Head Sail Sonar – Jib only
4. Head Sail Shark
  - a. 110%
  - b. 180%
5. Spinnaker
6. Race Sails – To be rolled not folded
