



SAIL SHARE (SS) – Everything you need to know:

Who is Eligible:

- Anyone who has their Basic Cruising or equivalent certification
- Must be a Sail Share member at either BYC or NSC
- Must be a full member of BYC or NSC (must upgrade from the 'free' crew membership)

Types of Sail Share Memberships:

- Tanzer/Shark (daylight hours only)
 - Level 1 (Sailing 7 days a week + Racing)
 - Level 2 (Sailing 7 days a week)
 - Level 3 (Sailing Mon-Fri, 9am-5pm)
 - Partner – same mailing address, cannot reserve boats
- Big Boat (C&C 27 - NSC or C&C 29 - BYC)
 - Level 2 (Sailing 7 days a week + overnights)
 - Level 3 (Sailing Mon-Fri, 9am-5pm)
 - Partner – same mailing address, cannot reserve boats
- Dinghy – Albacores
 - Level 1 (Sailing 7 days a week + Racing)
 - Level 2 (Sailing 7 days a week)
 - Level 3 (Sailing Mon-Fri, 9am-5pm)
 - Partner – same mailing address, cannot reserve boats

How to Enrol

1. Contact the office and arrange a time to come in to register with Advantage Boating and fill out the paperwork
2. Obtain a membership at the Club you choose to join SS with
3. Schedule a Sail Share orientation ~ 3 hours and includes a sail
4. ENJOY THE BOATS and GO SAILING

Boat Reservation: This is done online using www.supersaas.com

SS Policies:

- Cannot sail alone. There must be a minimum of 2 sailors on board with Basic Cruising or the equivalent certification
- Guests are permitted up to 3 visits each, after which they are asked to join
- Tanzers/Sharks are not permitted to sail in the dark
