



Keep Developing Your Instructor Skills:

If you are teaching regularly for Advantage Boating, you are welcome to attend any of our seminars for free (eg. outboard engine, diesel engine) or other courses at a reduced rate (eg. coastal or celestial navigation, intro to racing).

Instructor certification:

Instructors must register with Sail Canada each year so that they are able to award cruising levels, have access to resources and are covered by the Sail Canada Coach & Instructor personal liability insurance). Contact Sam Crothers at Sail Canada for more information (613.545.3044 Ext.105). Please provide the office with the copy of your current "certificate" once registered.

In order to maintain your instructor cruising certification you must:

1. Register each year with Sail Canada
2. Teach a minimum of 3 Sail Canada courses per season
3. Hold a current Standard First Aid & CPR level A certificate (these are typically good for 2-3 years depending on the agency who issued it)
4. Recertification is required for all instructor levels within 36 months of the first calendar yearend following the last day of an initial certification, recertification or IDP as authorized by the Sail Canada Training and Certification Committee.
